

Consensual Monitoring of Wireless Telephone by Law Enforcement

Certification of Authority to Monitor without Court Order


Pursuant to Florida Statute 934.03(2)(a)2 b, this certification is made in writing by a law enforcement officer, MBI AGENT WILLIAM MOORE, who is a person specified in Florida Statute 934.09(7) as having been designated by the State Attorney of the Ninth Judicial Circuit to authorize the interception or monitoring of communications without a prior court order, under limited circumstances as set out within the Florida Statutes.

It is hereby certified, after an examination of applicable law, that, pursuant to Florida Statute 934.03(2)(c) no warrant or court order is needed to make the herein requested interception and monitoring of all communications on the wireless telephone service accessed by the unique AT&T wireless telephone number [REDACTED] as consent has been given by the user and subscriber to the wireless telephone, ANTHONY M. LAZZARO, who is a person who will be a party to all such communications and said interception and monitoring will be done by, and at the direction of, a law enforcement officer who is doing so for the purpose to obtain evidence of a criminal act.

Accordingly, pursuant to Florida Statute 934.03(2)(a)2, any officer agent, or employee of AT&T or any other provider of telecommunications, or wire, oral, or electronic communication services, may provide information, facilities, or technical assistance to the above named law enforcement officer and other agents working in concert to further the criminal investigation.

In order to protect the rights of third parties, the consenting party will be required to read and sign a written consent to the interception and monitoring that contains a written acknowledgement pledging that the wireless telephone will not be used by any other person who has not also signed the same written consent and acknowledgement. A copy of same will be provided upon request.

Accordingly, it is requested that AT&T provide all assistance needed to implement the requested interception and monitoring of the above described wireless telephone as soon as possible as this investigation is a matter of great urgency that could affect matters of life, well-being, or death, of a child.






